

# My Tarot Persona: Who Am I in the . . .



This spread is a fun way to see what the tarot gods really think of you. My model echoes Jung's four cognitive functions, but with the "action" of Fire standing in for Jung's "intuition." The esoteric path will report on a higher order of consciousness to the extent you've attained one, while the exoteric path will outline your more mundane nature. The eight drawn cards serve as adverbs modifying the modes of expression for the central verbs. The "quints" provide a trump-card "Avatar" for each path that may be useful as a Significator in lieu of a court card when working with more profound questions. Otherwise, it shows your state of "becoming" in the Universe at the time of the reading, whether in cosmic (esoteric) terms or more prosaic (exoteric) ones. Reversals are not used since you have no place to hide from the pitiless gaze of the gods!

Choose an esoteric deck like the Thoth, the Tabula Mundi, the Liber T, Tarot of Stars Eternal, the Hermetic or similar for Line #1 and an exoteric deck like the Waite-Smith Tarot or clone, or an older traditional deck like the Tarot de Marseille, for Line #2. (Although the RWS is not truly an exoteric deck, it's used that way by most people.)
